

Saint Arnold Beer Garden + Restaurant

Houston, TX

A primary focus of the Saint Arnold Beer Garden was to create a pedestrian experience that is equally inviting for the restaurant and beer garden as it is to the Brewery.

This project is based on a long term vision of the brewery to expand their business and offer a more complete pedestrian experience. The Brewery's expansion creates a destination for beer lovers, bringing a new restaurant, outdoor deck, beer garden, gaming area with bocce courts and cornhole, and flexible activity lawn. There is even an off-leash area for dog-accompanied patrons.

The 115,000-SF, covered, outdoor beer garden is around an open courtyard and provides great connections to the brewery and the bocce courts, which have unobstructed views of downtown. This expansion attracts people for an entire day, rather than only for tours - encouraging and engaging visitors to eat, play and connect. The site also allows for festivals, events and various art exhibition space year-round.

Various street improvements including sidewalk widening and landscaped streetscape will provide a more comfortable and inviting environment for pedestrians and act as a catalyst for growth and revitalization within an industrial neighborhood.
