Mixed-Use District



- + A former industrial hub, East Village is currently experiencing an era of rapid economic expansion driven by an increase in cultural amenities, retail options, and residential communities.
- + Envisioned as a hub for community activity, East Village green will be the neighborhood's signature open space.
- + As selected by the General Public during the outreach process, the “Central Green” plan proposes a three-phase approach that organizes the park into a series of central open spaces surrounded by specialized amenities.
- + The first phase of construction includes the 60,000 SF west block; 20,000 SF of City-controlled property on the eastern superblock; and a 2-story, 300-car underground public parking garage.
- + Phase Two may include an additional structure or a subterranean utility substation that would enable the third and final phase of park improvements.



Located on a four-acre site in the heart of San Diego’s burgeoning East Village neighborhood, East Village Green is a highly programmed urban park supports a wide range of public amenities. OJB led a series of community engagement workshops to generate ideas, identify needs, and gauge interests. The feedback collected during these workshops was integrated into the design process to ensure an outcome that best represents the East Village community.
